Re: International Student Health Insurance Plan

St. Andrews Presbyterian College is concerned with the health and well being of its students. Many international students studying in this country do not have health insurance and therefore risk medical expenses which can jeopardize completion of their education. It is our intent to ensure all degree seeking students are protected and to comply with recent guidelines mandated by the U.S. Department of Immigration and Naturalization Services; therefore we are making available a health insurance policy.

All international students are required to have insurance. The cost of this plan is included in your tuition bill. The cost of the annual plan, which provides 12 months of coverage, is \$972.

**Participation in this plan is required of all international students.**

We think you will find the plan benefits are comprehensive and will cover most of your health care needs while at school. We have enclosed a summary for you. Please take time to review it.

Although in many countries the government bears the expense of health care for its citizens, and sometimes even visitors, individuals and families in the United States are responsible for purchasing coverage if an employer does not sponsor such a plan. The plan described is designed to ensure that you have adequate health insurance so that hospitals and doctors will provide treatment and care.
